



IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR HOUSEHOLD MOVES TO MEXICO

- You will need an FM3 visa, an FM2 Visa or documents proving that you are a returning Mexican citizen.
 - An FM3 visa is a legal permit issued by Mexican Consulates to live and/or work in Mexico. You will have to go personally to the nearest Mexican Consulate to request this document with the required information. It is the most frequently issued visa to work or retire in Mexico.
 - An FM2 visa leads to permanent residency status and citizenship in Mexico. It is not available from a Mexican Consulate in the U.S. You can get an FM2 at your local Immigration office in Mexico (INM Institución Nacional de Migración).
